 - Per DHCS, R69 is not in the DSM5 and should no longer be used.
 - F84.0 Autistic Disorder added as an included diagnosis for Outpatient & Day Services.
 - For those who would have been diagnosed with Asperger's or PDD NOS under DSM-IV, should now be given a diagnosis of Autistic Disorder (Autism Spectrum Disorder) under DSM-V.
 - "If you can treat it, treat it" If not, refer out for appropriate services (Regional Center/Managed Care). DHCS All Plan Letter 18-006.
