Capacity Building Projects - Brainstorm/Discussion

- Subcommittee discussed communities to potentially focus on for current fiscal year projects based on data and critical need:
 - 1. Ace/aro spectrum awareness
 - 2. API communities
 - 3. BIPOC-inclusive
 - 4. Bisexual awareness
 - 5. Black communities
 - 6. Black gay men elders
 - 7. Consumer populations (also recommended to include in all future projects)
 - 8. Elders
 - 9. Indigenous communities
 - 10. Intersex awareness
 - 11. Justice involved LGBTQ+ youth
 - 12. Latinx communities
 - 13. LGBTQ+ foster youth
 - 14. Neurodiverse communities
 - 15. Transgender communities
- Consider a collective/united campaign developed by the subcommittee as a whole

Recommendations/Discussion

- Provide education to individuals proposing project ideas on how to present their ideas and what the solicitation/bidding process consists of. Possibly partner established organizations with individuals with less experience proposing ideas (mentorship)
- How do we address sustainability
- Explore the available resources that are being allocated towards youth vs. aging communities
- Be mindful of using the language "inclusive" or "inclusion", it implies that there is a spot for you, but does not look at what work is actually being done. Instead focus on being "culturally empathetic"
- Look at what way these projects will address stigma, how will they outreach, how will they educate the people they're trying to reach, providing them with information, educating that community, creating a pathway
- Request additional funding for this subcommittee due to the many overlapping identities and the need for more capacity building projects
- Look at opportunities to partner with other UsCC, collaborate on projects

SOGI Board Motion/Training - Update

- All LA County departments are working on the implementation phase
- Dr. Gitlin is working with the clinical informatics team at DMH to see how best to roll out these changes
- Also looking at training for all staff on how best to ask questions related to SOGI identities
- Board of Supervisors also put out a mandate for more gender affirming services across the different County departments working on the Board response and partnering with teams at DHS and other departments
- Open invitation to subcommittee members to be involved in these conversations
- Ryan asked what the criteria are for "affirming providers" possible conversation for a future meeting

- Alexsis and Jamie from DCFS Office of Equity, LGBTQ+ to possibly put together a presentation for the subcommittee on the work happening at DCFS
- Black Gay Men's Wellness Month happening in August visit In The Meantime Men's Facebook page for upcoming events
- Colors at Antioch is starting to offer CEUs Bill Sive is doing a piece on working with gay elders, upcoming training for parents of gender expansive youth, etc.
