LACDMH Newsletter "Cultural Traditions and Connections" - Update	<ul> <li>Dr. George Gharibian and Mariam Nahapeyan were selected to be the EE/ME Liaisons for the LACDMH Newsletter "Cultural Traditions and Connections" committee.</li> <li>Mariam Nahapetyan shared with the group that they will be changing the Newsletter to a magazine due to an over abundant submission of topics and content.</li> <li>They gave an update on what kind of content the magazine would have. The content will be about Mental Health and community traditions and connections.</li> <li>The bulk of the information/content will come from the community. There will be a section for resources and a section for the community to ask questions.</li> <li>There was a discussion on what areas/places the magazine would be distributed to and how the magazine would be distributed, either by hard copy or a link.</li> <li>It was decided it will be distributed within DMH and outside DMH. To service providers, also having it on the DMH website and sharing with stakeholder groups. - Mastaneh Moghadam shared with the group, that they received a lot of positive feedback from the capacity building project movie Wake-up Sleeping Beauty.
- It was suggested for a future capacity building project, that they make a copy of the screenplay and revise it to a book in English, Russian and Persian.
- Also maybe a stage production Theater project, it would be nice for the community to come out and connect in that manner.

#### **Updates:**

• Dr. Shushan Kalantaryan shared with the group that this is the first time in history the Armenian government has recognized Mental Health to be an official field.

	<ul> <li>The Armenian government agreed to provide money needed for Mental Health services.</li> <li>Volunteers will be sent to Armenia to help with training on intense trauma work to help children and families.</li> <li>Masaneh Moghadam shared with the group that Cross-Cultural Expressions is looking to hire a Farsi speaking Clinician. They could be an intern, MSW, LCSW, MFT or LMFT. They have to be fluent in Farsi.</li> <li>Dr. George Gharibian shared with the group that they are trying to create a suicide helpline in Armenia, or a kind of helpline for people to get help if they are not comfortable with therapy or not able to receive therapy.</li> </ul>
