

Amendments to the 4/28/2022 Mental Health Commission Motion regarding Office of Diversion and Reentry (ODR)

Amendment 1:

The Department of Mental Health (DMH) reports back to the Mental Health Commission at its May 2022 meeting with recommendations on how the ODR-DMH Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) “operational pieces” can enhance reimbursements such as Medi-Cal and other state and federal funding.

Amendment 2:

The Department of Mental Health report back to the Mental Health Commission at its May 2022 with recommendations on enhancing client/mental health outcome data from ODR.

Amendment 3:

The Department of Mental Health report back to the Mental Health Commission at its May 2022 meeting as to what category the ODR funding will be allocated and what, if any, specific MHSA state requirements need to be addressed regarding the allocation.

Amendment 4:

The recommendation for ODR MHSA funding be subject to 30-day community input hearing.

Amendment 5:

Ensure MHSA funds will not supplant other funds.

Amendment 6:

Add details on a budget; report back on metrics and health outcomes, people that get out of jail due to this funding and data sharing
