Co-Chair Report Out	 Sylvia Gonzales-Youngblood updated the subcommittee regarding the co-chair visits to the various other stakeholder groups to present regarding Native history. They still plan to attend the LGBTQIA2-S UsCC in June and then the other SALT groups. The Wellness Forums are wrapping up. Sylvia updated the subcommittee regarding Dr. Sherin's retirement as Director for DMH. Sylvia and Hector shared information regarding CARE Court. Kelly to send out the meeting details to the listserv. Kelly updated the subcommittee regarding the increase in funding for capacity building projects from 200k to 350k/fiscal year. Capacity Project brainstorming will take place during the next few monthly meetings. Dr. Luis Guzman, liaison for the API and Latino UsCCs, is working on developing a framework for a Youth Advisory Council. As part of this effort, each of the UsCCs will have one youth (aged 16-24) identified as a cochair. Dr. Guzman to present at a future meeting regarding this.
