	stakeholder process as materials and information are not provided in Spanish
	or are provided last minute or after the fact despite repeated community
	requests
	iii. Community members shared concern that DMH does not follow-up or follow-
	through and that they are wasting their time in providing feedback every month
	and engaging with DMH
	iv. Comments by community members indicated many in the Latino community
	wonder if the Latino community is important to DMH Director Dr. Wong and
	executive leadership since they do not have time nor put in much effort to
	address key mental health issues impacting Latino community
	v. Community shared frustration and anger at lack of responsiveness by DMH
	towards Latino community as reflected in the annual budgets and requested
	that letter from Latino UsCC go to BOS
