- Pending: Wendy Cabil, *Black Homeless Outreach*, and Senait Admassu, *Prevention Works 4 Communities* (*PW-4- C*)
- Work will begin on new proposals for CBP

Presentation: Hands4Hope LA:

- 501 (c)(3) nonprofit organization, prevention & early intervention program, empowering at-risk youth
- Provide resources (free afterschool programs, academic and creative activities, nutritional snacks, and enriching field trips) for youth ages 8 to 24 and their parents from low income, underserved, predominantly single parent minority households
- Staff trained to foster positive social skills and teach children how to communicate with one another and have empathy for one another
- Promotes diversity and inclusion
- Offer STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, and math) classes

Black Maternal Health (BMH) Town Halls Presentation & Black Mental Health Task Force (BMHT): BMHT

- Formed and led by community-based organizations
- Board led decision-based structure on funding
- 75 members who have signed membership agreements
- New Vice Chairs of Advocacy and Outreach: Keith & Nashan Mitchell BMH Town Halls

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- Recruited 11 Black mothers for DMH, to do a series of workshops and interviews and film project
- Created a community survey that is Black mama-led
- Gathering 100 unique surveys from Black mothers on how better to serve them
- February had a 4-day Mental Health Summit, of which 2-day Town hall workshop took place
- Premiere of 1hour 15-minute documentary series

CBP Update: Strengthening Community Connections for Black Men-Boys Project: Dr. Donald E. Grant Jr.

- A study on how Black me perceive their services in LA County, their awareness of their history and how it impacts their current mental health
- In need of more men to sign up, take surveys
- Have held 2 sessions working with Cal State Dominguez Hills and a football program in Long Beach
- Working to create a cohort for 25 men
- Program begins April 14, 2023
