
## Consumer Satisfaction Survey Summary Spring 2020 – Older Adult Version


The Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health administers surveys over the course of one week twice a year to assess how our consumers feel about our services. In Spring 2020, we received **8,615** complete responses. **Older Adults** had the fewest surveys at **493** or **5.7%** of all surveys.



**97%** of **Older Adults** were very satisfied that staff treated them with respect.




72% of Older Adults were very satisfied that their symptoms were not bothering them as much.




Most of the survey participants were Latino, which reflects Los Angeles County.



**96%** of **Older Adults** were very satisfied with the times that treatment was available and felt the times were good for them.



71% of Older Adults were very satisfied that that their housing situation had improved.



Most of the surveys were completed in **English** or **Spanish** with a smaller number in **Korean** and **Vietnamese**.
