Description of Site: (Please describe the type of Agency setting and services offered)

Hollywood Mental Health Center (MHC) is an adult outpatient clinic we serve individuals age 18 and over. While all of our clients have a mental health diagnosis, many would be considered to have severe and persistent mental illness, including psychotic, trauma-related, depressive, bipolar, and co-occurring disorders. Hollywood MHC provides individual and group psychotherapy, case management, crisis intervention, and medication support services. We are preparing to re-launch psychological assessment services over the coming months, with psychological assessment opportunities to be available to practicum students.

This is an especially exciting time to join our team, as we are in the midst of a groundbreaking innovation in mental health service delivery. The Hollywood Collaborative includes Hollywood MHC's adult outpatient program, Hollywood MHC's Full-Service Partnership intensive fieldbased program, and the new Hollywood 2.0 field-capable clinical services program. Through the Hollywood Collaborative's 5-year innovation period, we are connecting internal resources
