

GLOSSARY OF TERMS AND ACRONYMS

“ARF” means Adult Residential Facility licensed by Community Care Licensing.

“Supportive Services – Intensive Residential Facilities” means essential services that may not be reimbursable under Medi-Cal or other benefits programs – e.g., augmented staffing ratios and housing expenses, personal/community integration expenses, housing services, employment services, transportation, food vouchers.

“CGF” means County General Funds.

“CSS” means Community Services and Supports Plan.

“DMH” means Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health.

“EPSDT” means the Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment program which provides medically necessary services to Medi-Cal eligible beneficiaries under 21 years of age. This program is a requirement of the Title XIX of the Social Security Act) Medi-Cal program to provide comprehensive health care.

“FFP” means Federal Financial Participation for Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal services including EPSDT services.

“FSP” means Full Service Partnership.

“IMD” means a hospital, nursing facility, or institution of more than 16 beds that is primarily engaged in providing diagnosis, treatment or care of persons with mental diseases, including medical attention, nursing care and related services.

“MHSA” means Mental Health Services Act.

“MOU” means Memorandum of Understanding.

“OE” means Outreach and Engagement.

“PMRT” means DMH Psychiatric Mobile Response Team, which conducts evaluations in the field in order to develop crisis intervention plans.

“RFS” means Request for Services.

“SDMH” means California State Department of Mental Health.

“SED” means Seriously Emotionally Disturbed.

“Service Area Navigator Team” is defined as a group of people working together at the Service Area level to outreach and engage local communities and link clients to services, with the purpose of creating enhanced and seamless networks of mental health care.

“SUPPORTIVE HOUSING” means rental housing where disabled individuals hold a lease c rental agreement in their own name, subject to applicable landlord-tenant laws, and where the may voluntarily choose to have support services for independent living.

“SGF” means California State General Funds used as FFP match.

“SOW” means Statement of Work.

“SPMI” means Severe and Persistently Mentally Ill.

“TAY” means Transition Age Youth.
