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### **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT PROPOSED HOUSING PROJECT MENLO FAMILY HOUSING CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

November 23, 2009

The Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health (LACDMH), as required under the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA), is opening a public review and comment period for the proposal submitted by Little Tokyo Service Center Community Development Corporation, project sponsor of the MENLO Family Housing, which is proposed to be funded through the MHSA Housing Program. Through this program, LACDMH was allocated \$115,571,200 for capital development and operating subsidies for permanent supportive housing for individuals with psychiatric disabilities and their families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. As required by the program, the funds were transferred to the California Housing Finance Agency (CalHFA), who will administer the funds and underwrite the loans. The project is located in Service Area 4 and Supervisorial District 2 and will target homeless Transition Age Youth. They are requesting a MHSA Capital Development loan of \$524,150 for the 5 MHSA funded units of a 60 unit project, which will be dedicated to individuals with a psychiatric disability.

The public review and comment period will run from November 23, 2009 through December 22, 2009.
