**Psychiatric Social Worker II — Spanish Speaking
CalWORKs 4 Kids Program**

Arcadia Mental Health Center is a clinic located in San Gabriel Valley with an opening for a Psychiatric Social Worker II (or Mental Health Clinician II) in the new CalWORKs 4 Kids program. This is a new program to address the needs of children of CalWORKs families. CalWORKs Mental Health Services are part of the Welfare-to-Work program that assists the adult participant to overcome mental health barriers to employment. The PSW II will provide field-based individual and family therapy as well as case management services, but the program will be housed at Arcadia MHC until a second clinic is developed in the East San Gabriel Valley sometime next year.

DUTIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Provides outpatient mental health treatment services including case management and individual and family therapy in the field for children whose parents are CalWORKs participants;
- Coordinates care with the clinician providing treatment for the CalWORKs parent;
- Maintains client charts, completes initial assessments & keeps up with detailed DMH documentation requirements;
- Obtains and maintains LPS designation to permit the completion of 5150 holds for clients assessed to be a danger to self or others.

DESIREABLE QUALITIES:

- Experience providing child and family therapy;
- Ability to be flexible with the evolving CalWORKs 4 Kids program;
- Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to work and communicate effectively with other County employees and community agencies;
- Superior time management skills;
- Ability to problem solve while working under pressure;
- Fluency in Spanish.
