Deadline for submission of your application has been extended to November 2, 2015.

Over \$3.9 million is available.

This year the County of Los Angeles criteria has expanded to include **personnel providing targeted case management and rehabilitative services as well as MAA and COS billing.** Personnel working (but not limited to) as employment specialists, medical case workers, occupational therapists and psychiatric technicians are a few of the occupational categories that may provide such direct services and qualify to apply.

PLEASE NOTE: MHLAP is specifically for personnel working in the public mental health system (Department of Mental Health [DMH] and its DMH-funded contracted programs and their respective subcontractors).
