El Cariso Regional Park Gymnasium and Community Building Celebrates \$11.5 Million Groundbreaking!


Los Angeles County Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky and the County of Los Angeles
Department of Parks and Recreation hosted a groundbreaking ceremony at El Cariso Regional
Park for its new state-of-the-art, \$11.5 million dollar gymnasium and community center on Saturday, October 15, 2011. The project will include a gymnasium, meeting rooms, kitchen, classroom/
computer lab, office, lobby, civic art, courtyard, storage, additional parking and restrooms. The
79-acre El Cariso Regional Park stands as a memorial to the El Cariso Hot Shots, a USDA-Forest
Service Firefighting crew who lost their lives during the Loop Fire in 1966. Speakers at the event
included Los Angeles County Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky, Department of Parks and Recreation
Director Russ Guiney; Department of Public Works Deputy Director Massood Eftekhari; Park Volunteer and Community Leader Alina Mendizabel and park patron and representative Irene Galva.
Thanks also go to the El Cariso Regional Park staff for their hard work on this special event and
for making the park look fantastic!

This pair of decorative wooden doors are part of the 1930 reconstruction of a theater formerly known as the Pilgrimage Play Theater. The original wooden theater, which had burned down, was replaced with a poured concrete design in the style of ancient Judaic architecture meant to resemble the gates of Jerusalem. This Amphitheatre, currently known as the John Anson Ford Amphitheatre, was re-named in honor of the former Supervisor.




