City of Arcadia	Santa Anita Wash Trail Improvement Project	The proposed project includes the redesign, relocation, and reconstruction of portions of the Los Angeles County's multi-use trail known as Santa Anita Wash Trail, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works Class 1 Bike lane, and fencing that separates the City of Arcadia's Par 3 Golf Course from the County's recreational use.	\$250,000.00
City of Bradbury	Bradbury Phase III Park Development Project	This project will finalize the construction of the Bradbury Civic Center Project. As the last of 3 phases, the Bradbury Phase III Park Development Project will serve as a drought tolerant demonstration site and will provide the community a location to congregate during the day and before and after City Council and other civic meetings.	\$24,000.00
City of Burbank	Earthwalk Park Playground Replacement and Landscape Improvement Project	This project will replace the antiquated playground equipment located at this park and will allow for the installation of new playground equipment and shade structure over the playground area. The City will also install a new rubberized surface around the entire play area. Furthermore, in an effort to conserve valuable water resources, the existing landscaping surrounding the park monument sign at this park will be replaced with drought tolerant California natives.	\$250,000.00

City of Duarte	Duarte Fish Canyon Falls Trail	Rehabilitation of approximately 1.6 miles of hiking trail to Fish Canyon Falls.	\$25,000.00
City of Glendale	Fitness in the Parks Project	Provide outdoor and indoor fitness equipment at three park facilities in underserved portions of the community with the specific target of at-risk-youth and seniors.	\$155,000.00
City of Glendora	Carty Property Multipurpose & Bathroom Project	Install bathroom and other amenities.	\$250,000.00
City of La Verne	Senior/Community Center HVAC Improvements	Construction and installation of a new HVAC system in the Senior/Community Center kitchen.	\$42,000.00
City of Lancaster	Eastside Pool Refurbishment	Improvements and additions to the 31 year-old indoor Eastside Pool aquatics facility to include painting of the interior of the pool structure, re-surfacing of the pool deck, purchasing and installing new partitions of the restrooms and showers, the addition of a variable speed pool pump, improvements to the lifeguard office and floor, and re-grouting the shower tile.	\$250,000.00

Build a swale for water retention and renovate the park entry area that will feature drought tolerant landscape, permeable concrete and signage.	\$250,000.00
City of Palmdale	McAdam Pool Rehabilitation	This project will accomplish many crucial repairs needed to the McAdam Pool. Repairs include but not limited to: new pool liner, chemical containment, upgrades to pool equipment; ADA upgrades in the pool building.	\$250,000.00
City of San Dimas	Marchant Park Recreation Building Rehabilitation Project	The project includes building expansion, interior improvements, restroom modifications, structural adjustments to interior spaces, restoration of interior and exterior finishes, and accessibility upgrades.	\$250,000.00
City of San Gabriel	Vincent Lugo Park Picnic Shelters	The project includes site preparation and installation of picnic shelters at Vincent Lugo Park.	\$250,000.00
