Simon Levy served as county supervisor for one term. He was one of seven supervisors who assumed office on Jan. 8, 1883, the result of a Board motion approved on Sept. 6, 1882 dividing the County into seven districts. On Aug. 5, 1884 the County was divided into five supervisorial districts, in accordance with Section 16 of the County Government Bill.

Levy owned a general store on Aliso Street in Los Angeles and he bought and sold supplies, including grain, wool and animal hides. His success in business and civic mindedness led to his election to the county supervisorial seat.
