Wallace L. Woodward served as county supervisor for one term. He was elected to office in November 1894 and assumed office on Jan. 7, 1895.

Woodward was born in 1833 in Long Island, N.Y. His early life was spent on the East Coast. At age 19, he moved to Chicago and later on to Iowa, where he lived from 1870 to 1885. While in Iowa, he worked in the hardware business.

In 1885 Woodward moved to Pasadena and became a real estate dealer. His business savvy and involvement in civic affairs led to his election to the supervisorial seat.

His credits included being a member of the Pasadena Commandery of Knights Templars and 32nd degree Mason.

On Feb. 13, 1902, Woodward died. He was 68, and was survived by a son, daughter, and sister.
