Sidney T. Graves served as county supervisor for one term. He assumed office on Dec. 6, 1926, replacing Frank E. Woodley.

After leaving office, Graves, a former chairman of the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, was convicted of receiving an \$80,000 bribe in connection with the building of the San Gabriel Dam. After serving two years of a six-year sentence in San Quentin, he was released on parole for good behavior.

In 1937 he returned to Los Angeles and indicated he planned to take a job with a construction company.
