Narrative:

Deputy personnel responded to 10100 block of Bogue Street in Temple City, regarding a home on fire with occupants inside. Upon arrival Deputy Reynaldo Lainez saw the residence on fire and quickly learned there was an elder male occupant with limited mobility trapped inside. Deputy Lainez without hesitation forced his way into the residence in order to locate the trapped man. After entering once and being forced out due to the heat and smoke, Deputy LianeZ entered a second time, located an eighty seven year old male and sole occupant lying on the floor with severe burns and unable to move. Deputy Lainez, with the assistance of three civilians, pulled the elderly man out of the fire to safety. The burn victim was transported to a local hospital for treatment. Deputy LianeZ, who suffered smoke inhalation during the rescue, was treated and released at a local hospital.
