NARRATIVE:

Jorge Banos has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 19. His convictions include vehicle theft, multiple cases of participating in a street gang, felon in possession of firearm, attempted vehicle theft, hit and run property damage, burglary, vehicle theft with priors and evading a peace officer. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 56 month sentence for participating in a street gang. Banos was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on December 09, 2018. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in September 2019 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Banos qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for grand theft with priors is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history, gang member status and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
