Juvenile Division:

- One DSO at Barry J. Nidorf Juvenile Hall tested positive in the last 24 hours. Individual is asymptomatic.
- There were five additional DSOs that were potentially exposed and will be self-monitoring for 14 days. Additionally, the 17 youth that were potentially exposed will be guarantined for 14 days (until 4/29).
- No youth are exhibiting any symptoms or illness. All of the DSOs were wearing masks during the potential exposure.
- Masks are now available to all youth in juvenile facilities.
