NARRATIVE:

Quincy Mack has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. His convictions include carrying a loaded firearm, burglary, domestic violence, possession of cocaine for sale, possession of narcotic controlled substances, possession of dangerous weapon, pimping, assault and battery. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being an 8 year term for pimping. Mack was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on November 22, 2019. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in March 2021 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Mack qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for pimping is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
