## **NARRATIVE:**

Juan Lopez has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. His convictions include robbery, battery, domestic violence, exhibiting a deadly weapon, grand theft, sales of marijuana, reckless driving, possess narcotic controlled substances, vehicle theft, petty theft and auto theft with priors. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 4 year term for auto theft with priors. Lopez was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on January 27, 2021. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in February 2021 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Lopez qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for auto theft with priors is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
