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PLEASE READ CARFULLY

A Reserve Deputy Probation Officer candidate must be 21 years of age and enrolled in college with a goal of attaining a baccalaureate degree. You must be a citizen of the USA or possess a valid USA Work Permit. Applicants with outstanding warrants are disallowed. There are four stages in the application procedure that must be successfully completed before you begin your service.

1 Complete Application

Print legibly in black ink completing all fields and affix signature. Only legible documents will be processed.

2 Interview

Upon review of your application, qualifying individuals will be scheduled for an oral interview before an interview board.

After successfully completing the interview process you will be required to complete a Personal History Statement.

You will also need to provide original documents identified in the Personal **History Statement for** review.

3 Background Investigation

A thorough background investigation will be conducted for applicants passing the board interview process.

Upon successful completion of a background investigation, you will be notified by the Reserve **Deputy Probation Officer** Program Coordinator that you have been cleared and you will be scheduled for mandatory orientation and the Reserve **Deputy Probation Officer** Academy.

Denial of clearance decisions are final and are not subject to appeal. Reserve Deputy Probation Officers are not covered under Civil Service.

4 Orientation & Training

Reserve Deputy Probation Officer Academy training is

mandatory. During the training you will be informed of pertinent rules and regulations governing contact with probationers, complete legal forms and agreements and receive clarification regarding the terms and conditions of your volunteer role.

At the conclusion of this session, you will be presented your official Probation Department ID Card.
