I have lived in this neighborhood since 1989. We were aware of Camps Scudder and Scott when we purchased our home. The camp had been there and their goal to help teens who had made relatively minor mistakes in their lives was and is great. We have often seen them playing sports but otherwise it's quiet.

The idea of putting jailed criminals within a neighborhood is absurd! You were given a brief amount of time to complete a task with these inmates. With a very influential group pushing at you (ARC), you sneak to withhold the information from the Santa Clarita City Council and make a decision to house them in a neighborhood (approximately 800 feet from the camp to the entrance to the neighborhood). Next door to the camp is a horseback riding school. We have schools and parks embedded every few miles! Turning left from the camps takes you directly into the Angeles National Forest!

We have asked many questions which you refuse to answer and ignore the community as though we have no right to receive answers. I know for a fact you have received many previous communications that would create a very long list of questions. Please respect us and answer them.

The ARC has resorted to name call the SCV community; I thought bullying was considered crass, rude, mean-spirited or many other descriptive definitions. This behavior does not garnet my respect nor my interest. You represent the county we live in and should not stand by this behavior.

Please listen to our community speak today and have the courtesy to listen, respond and respect what we and our City Council is telling you; our neighborhood is not the place to put a prison! Sincerely,
