A REMINDER TO REGISTER

The County's Vaccination Policy went into effect on Friday, October 1, 2021. According to the Policy, ALL MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY WORKFORCE must register in the Fulgent system whether you are vaccinated, semi-vaccinated, or intend to request an exemption.

If you have not already done so, please register as soon as possible using this link: <u>lac.fulgentgenetics.com</u>. If you are submitting an exemption request, please forward completed forms directly to Probation HR. Email: <u>Deanna.Carlisle@probation.lacounty.gov</u>. For RTSB/DSB staff who need to test weekly as outlined under the County Vaccination policy, we are working with DHR to obtain self-test kits and more information will be provided shortly. For all other staff who need to test as outlined under the policy, please make sure you are using specific-designated County employee test locations so your test results upload in the County Fulgent database.

Here is a listing and links for County Employee only test locations. Testing and travel may be completed during your regular working hours (code 099/COV), however please coordinate your time with your supervisor in advance to minimally impact services or work needs.
