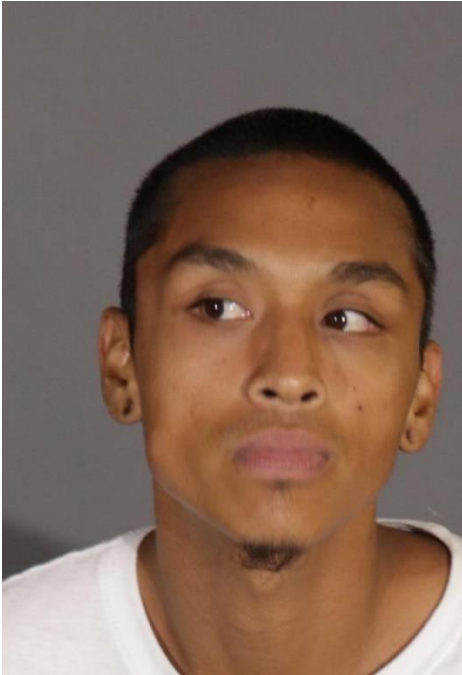

NARRATIVE:

Andrew Santa Maria has an extensive adult criminal history. His convictions include arson, causing fire to inhabited structure, inmate in possession of hand cuff key, vehicle theft, possession of controlled substances, possession of controlled substances in prison, resisting a peace officer, shoplifting, and vandalism. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 2 year term for arson. Santa Maria was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on August 3, 2020. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in November 2021 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Santa Maria qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for arson is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
