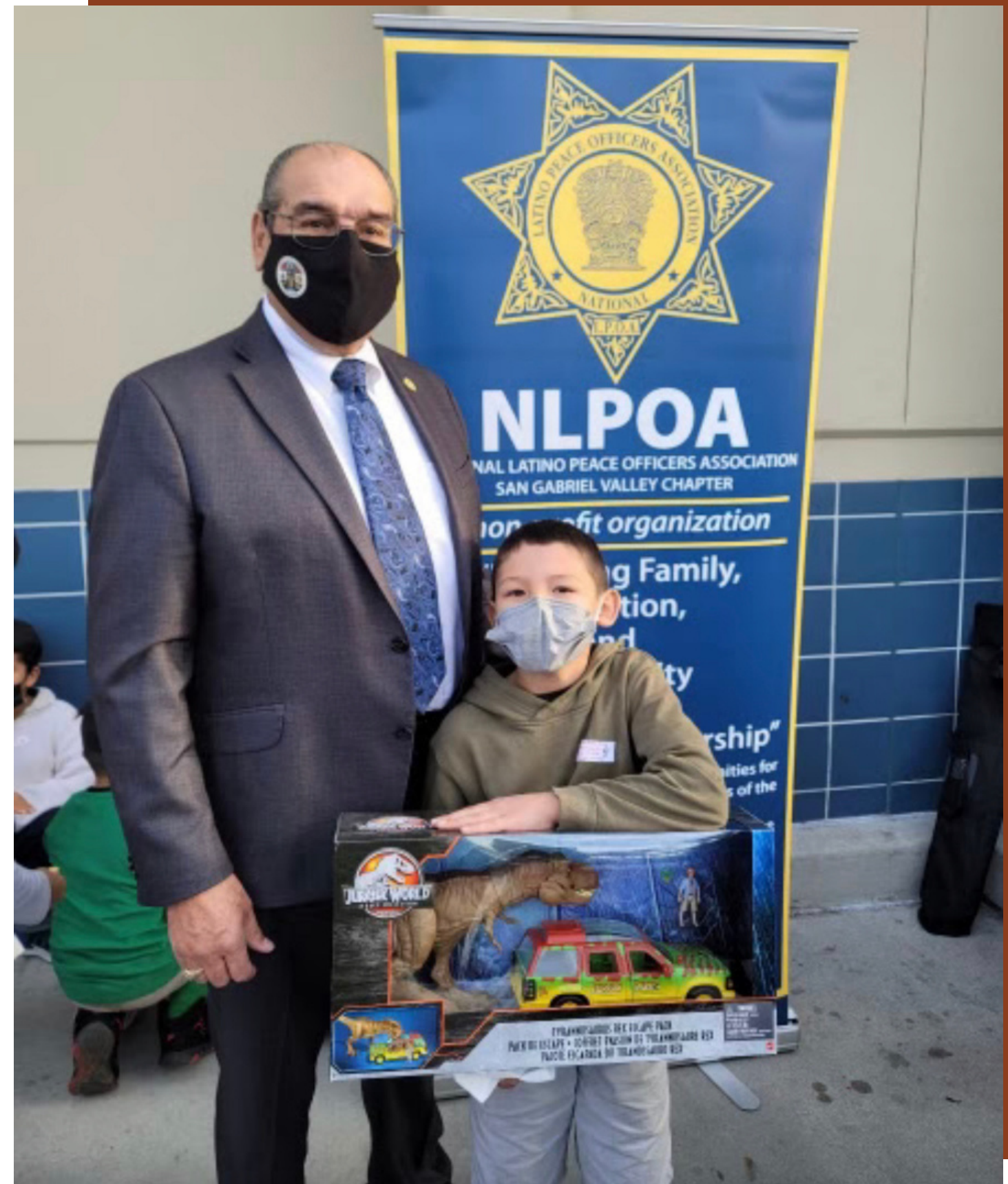
You and your co-workers are an essential part of our department. We cannot serve our communities with expertise and diligence without our health. They are counting on us.
