On March 15, 2022, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors approved the following actions and determined that they are not considered to be a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): Further exploration of the potential future identification of the following facilities: Campus Kilpatrick and Camp Scott as the Secure Youth Track Facility (SYTF) for male youth and Dorothy Kirby Center as the permanent SYTF for female youth; secure youth treatment facilities, further exploration of the potential future identification of Los Angeles County juvenile halls as permanent locations for youth awaiting disposition or transfer to disposition only, as qualified, develop a plan for proposed renovations and any other potential modifications, develop an implementation plan for staffing and implement and oversee a Credible Messenger mentorship pilot at Campus Kilpatrick.
