It is the goal of the Los Angeles County Probation Department to offer high quality training that is designed to promote and support the Department's Vision of rebuilding lives and providing healthier and safer communities. The Probation Department Staff Training Office is committed to partnering with all to facilitate training that enhances the skillset of all its employees.

Created in 1980 to establish and maintain statewide standards that assist local sheriffs, probation, police, and corrections departments in selecting and training their professional corrections personnel, Standards and Trainings for Corrections (STC) also helps departments meet these standards by providing technical assistance and a comprehensive statewide training delivery system. The BSCC's STC Division works in collaboration with the County of Los Angeles Probation Department to improve the professional competence for all staff.

Established in 2012, the California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is an independent statutory agency that provides leadership to the adult and juvenile criminal justice systems, expertise on Public Safety Realignment issues, a data and information clearinghouse, and technical assistance on a wide range of community corrections issues. (Penal Code sec. 6024-6025).

In addition, the BSCC promulgates regulations for adult and juvenile detention facilities and conducts regular inspections of those facilities. The BSCC develops standards for the selection and training of local corrections and probation officers to administer significant public safety related grant funding.
