JUNETEENTH – A CELEBRATION



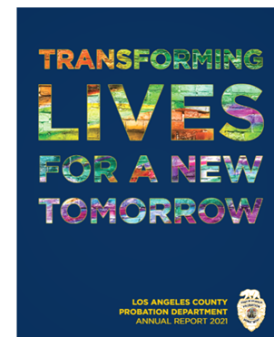
