MEET THE PROBATION CARE TEAM

PCT FOCUSES ON EMPLOYEE HEALTH AND WELLNESS

The Probation Care Team (PCT) was created during the COVID-19 pandemic to serve as wellness ambassadors on behalf of Chief Probation Officer Dr. Adolfo Gonzales. On July 13, 2021, Supervisor Janice Hahn made a Board Motion to create a countywide wellness unit in response to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. Supervisor Hahn's Board Motion further enhanced the importance and necessity of the PCT's roles, responsibilities, and duties. The Probation Care Team's mission is to help support probation employees throughout their healing process while recovering from injury.

The PCT offers in-person visits at the employees' residences with the primary focus on their recovery, health, and wellness. The four-person unit includes SDPO Regino "Reggie" Torres, Jr., SDPO Brett Sakoda, DPO Chad McMillan, and Transportation Deputy Luis Melendez. DPO II Monique Newson will be joining the Probation Care Team soon.

How it works: Members of the PCT will visit the employee at home and provide wellness resources centered on the employee and their recovery process. "We educate the employee on the Probation Support Services (PSS) program, Employee Assistance Program (EAP), Peer Support, and Chaplaincy programs," said team leader SDPO Torres. "An employee should return to work only when they are mentally and physically able."

The PCT provides referrals to Peer support to all employees they visit. Members of the PCT have successfully completed the 3-Day Peer Support Training. "We've worked throughout the halls, camps, and in the field," said SDPO Sakoda. "One of us has worked in every operation within the department so we have that experience, and we understand what people are going through because we have actually been there and done that job." The PCT will listen, assess, and refer employees to professional therapists when necessary. The PCT will follow up and ensure linkage of services was provided to the employee. Many of our Probation employees have been referred to the Probation Support Services (PSS) program on behalf of PCT Supervisors.


