## DIALECTICAL BEHAVIOR THERAPY (DBT) TRAINING SERVICES RFP #6402207 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1.	Question	COUNTY STAFF
		<ul> <li>a. Who are the county staff as identified in the document?</li> <li>b. What experience do they have?</li> <li>c. What is their level of education?</li> <li>d. Do they currently conduct DBT?</li> <li>e. How many of them are DBT-Certified?</li> </ul>
	Answer	Probation officers that will be identified for the training will be selected on their interest and demonstrated ability to run therapeutic cognitive behavioral groups and engage youth. All selected will have a college degree. The administration of DBT is currently done by Department of Mental Health. Some individuals may have been trained in DBT in the past but there is an undetermined number of how many have previously been trained and are certified in DBT.
2.	Question	TRAINING FORMAT
		In the RFP, it is written that this training occurs "at a probation facility" but it does not specify that all training would need to be done in person. Does all of the training need to be done in person, or can it be done virtually? If it must be done in person, is there a designated location yet?
	Answer	All training does not have to be done in person. Training that is conducted in person will be scheduled in advance at a predetermined County location. It may be held at Probation's training facility in Pico Rivera or may take place at a Probation Camp; it is expected that the contractor has the ability to be flexible to meet Probation's needs.
3.	Question	If a hybrid approach of In Person and Virtual can be utilized, is there a required percentage of either (ex.: 50% virtual, 50% in person)?
	Answer	There is no predetermined percentage of in-person and virtual training. It is important that proposers clearly demonstrate the ability to deliver quality training that meets the outlined needs whether the training is in-person or virtual.
