Probation Launches Web Page Dedicated to the Los Padrinos Depopulation Plan

On Friday, May 30th, the Los Angeles County Probation Department launched a web page dedicated to the Los Padrinos depopulation plan.

This web page is designed to assist parents and guardians of youth, community members, and others to better understand the court ordered plan approved by Judge Michael Espinoza on May 16, 2025 to depopulate Los Padrinos Juvenile Hall and relocate youth to other facilities.

Chief Viera Rosa, Department Leaders Meet with La Verne and San Dimas Leaders

This week, Probation Chief Guillermo Viera-Rosa and members of the LA County Probation

Department's executive team met with officials from the Cities of La Verne and San Dimas.

They discussed the court-approved plan for Los Padrinos Juvenile Hall, which includes transferring youth to other existing facilities, as well as upgrading the mission of some of those facilities to better meet the needs of the offenders in our custody and care. La Verne and San Dimas are home to the department's camp community placement population. Youth are assigned there by order of the court based on their behavior, and they receive treatment and rehabilitative services so they can successfully reenter the community. Our leadership is fully committed to ongoing communication and collaboration with our local partners, especially as our shared mission is to ensure the community's public safety. We thank the leaders of La Verne and San Dimas for their feedback and engagement. Probation will be meeting with other city officials in the coming weeks.

Los Angeles County Probation Participates in Community Meetings with County Partners

This week, Acting Chief Deputy Gabriella Aguilera joined community meetings in Lancaster and Sylmar to speak directly with residents about the upcoming youth transfers from Los Padrinos Juvenile Hall. Organized by our partners at the Department of Youth Development, the meetings also included participation from DYD Director David Carroll, Karen Streich from the Department of Mental Health, and other agency representatives. We're grateful to the community members who attended and shared their ideas to help strengthen communication and support for youth and families during this transition.

Camp Paige Transfers Completed

As part of its efforts to implement the Los Padrinos Depopulation Plan and modernize its juvenile facilities, the Los Angeles County Probation Department has completed relocating youth and staff from Camp Paige to Camps Afflerbaugh and Rockey. This move will enable critical infrastructure improvements at Camp Paige while ensuring continuity of care. Staff will also be reassigned to the other camps. There were no issues with the move.
