

Weekly Update: July 25, 2025

Court Updates

On July 18th, Chief Probation Officer Viera Rosa appeared in court for an update with Judge Espinoza.

This week, the state's Attorney General announced his intent to file a motion seeking to put the Department's juvenile hall/s into a receivership. The court hearing the motion gave the County 30 days to respond, and a court hearing is set for mid-September. Probation Leadership presents at the Probation Oversight Commission Meeting

On July 24, Chief Probation Officer Guillermo Viera Rosa addressed the Probation Oversight Commission, providing key updates on the depopulation of Los Padrinos Juvenile Hall, the department's status with the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC), and the recent filing by the California Attorney General.

Deanna Carlise, Director of Human Resources, shared updates on staffing efforts and initiatives. Probation Director Rene Martinez presented on the department's compliance with the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA), including policy updates and training developments.
