Last month, the Los Angeles County Probation Department, in partnership with local law enforcement, conducted multiple compliance checks—leading to several arrests and the seizure of illegal weapons, drugs, and contraband.

- ◆ Hollywood (March 25): 4 arrests, including probation violations & drug-related charges. Weapons & drug paraphernalia recovered.
- ◆ Los Angeles (March 26): AR-15 rifle & methamphetamine seized from a probationer's residence.
- ◆ Pomona (March 27): Youth probationer with an outstanding warrant arrested for firearm possession.

The department remains committed to public safety, accountability, and reducing recidivism.
