Collaboration Leads to Arrest and Weapon Recovery



The Hollenbeck Gang Unit 4G3 recently observed a known gang member and active probation client walking down the street. The individual, who had a no-bail warrant and two active formal probation cases, fled into his residence and attempted to escape through the back door. With assistance from LAPD's Airship and K-9 units, the individual was located and taken into custody.

Following the arrest, the Los Angeles County Probation Department conducted a compliance search of the residence, resulting in the recovery of a modified sawed-off shotgun and multiple rounds of ammunition.

This successful operation highlights the ongoing collaboration between local law enforcement agencies in maintaining public safety and enforcing probation conditions.

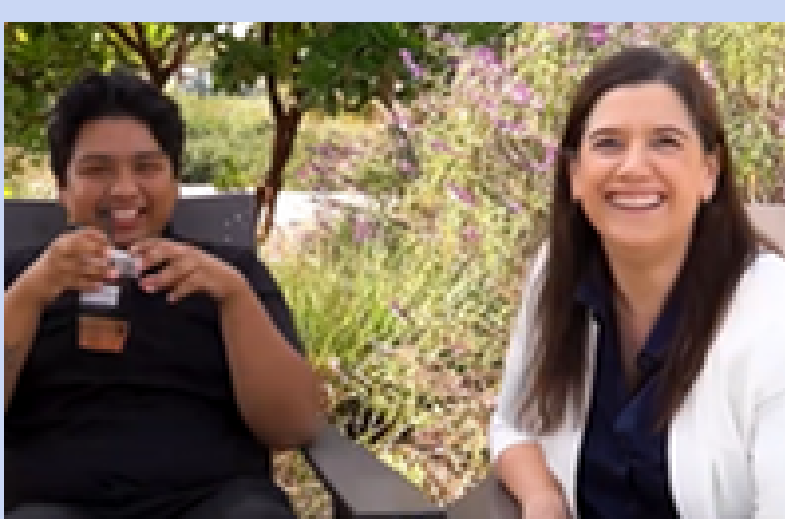
