

Weekly Update: OCTOBER 17, 2025

Court Hearings

On October 10, Chief Probation Officer Viera-Rosa appeared in court in response to the Attorney General's petition seeking to place the Los Angeles County Probation Department under receivership. After hearing from both the Probation Department and the State's representatives, Judge Hernandez continued the matter to October 24, 2025, for an evidentiary hearing.

Youth, Family and Staff Engagement

Youth townhalls were held at Los Padrinos Juvenile Hall on Tuesday, October 14, and Thursday, October 16. Probation staff, together with community partners, met with the youth to share information and answer questions regarding the upcoming transfers to Campus Kilpatrick.
