

## **Weekly Update: December 19, 2025**

### **Court Hearings**

The court hearing regarding the Attorney General's petition seeking to place the Los Angeles County Probation Department under receivership was rescheduled to January 12, 2026.

The Department's hearing regarding the Los Padrinos Depopulation plan with Judge Espinoza's was also postponed. As of this update, the date is unknown.

### **Los Angeles County Probation Department Completes Relocation of Los Padrinos Female and Gender-Expansive Youth to Campus Kilpatrick**

The Los Angeles County Probation Department has completed the relocation of all female and gender-expansive youth from Los Padrinos Juvenile Hall to Campus Kilpatrick in Malibu, in accordance with the court-approved depopulation plan.

The phased transition was completed over several weeks to ensure safety, youth acclimation, staff readiness, and continuity of care. The relocation occurred without incident. Eighteen youth now reside at Campus Kilpatrick, which is fully operating as a dedicated, small-group, therapeutic facility for girls and gender-expansive youth. There are no pregnant youth at the facility.

Campus Kilpatrick provides individualized, trauma-informed care, including education, behavioral health services, mentorship, recreation, and life-skills programming. Probation engaged youth, families, and community partners throughout the process to support transparency and continuity of services.

### **Campus Kilpatrick (CVK) Visiting**

Visitation at Campus Vernon Kilpatrick is Saturdays and Sundays from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Only approved parents, legal guardians, and grandparents may visit. Legal guardians must show court verification. Baby bonding visits may be scheduled outside regular hours.

Parents may drive themselves. November transportation support is available through the Department of Youth Development. Approved visitors using rideshare support must report

to Los Padrinos Juvenile Hall by 11:30 a.m. for a 12:00 p.m. departure. Pickup and drop off is in front of the Los Padrinos parking structure facing west toward the golf course. Call (818)889-1353 by 6:00 p.m. the night before to request rideshare. Minor children are not allowed on rideshare. For questions ask for Officers Rainey or Molina.

All visitors are subject to search. No personal items may enter the facility. Anyone suspected of being under the influence will be denied entry.

## **Campus Kilpatrick Visitor Guidelines**

### **Dress Code**

- Shoes must be always worn.
- **Do NOT wear:**
- - White t-shirts as outerwear, strapless, spaghetti strap, halter, tank, or see-through tops
  - Short skirts/dresses above mid-thigh, shorts, tight-fitting clothing, low-cut tops, or midriff-baring clothes
  - Clothing with offensive messages/insignias, gang symbols, sexual or lewd images
  - Hats, bandanas, sunglasses, broaches, stickpins
  - Open-toed shoes or heels over 2 inches

**Note:** Visitors inappropriately dressed may need to reschedule and will not be allowed entry.

### **Items Not Allowed**

For safety and security, the following are **prohibited**:

- Writing tools: pens, pencils, markers
- Metal items: handcuffs, keys, paperclips, staples, pointers, laser pointers
- Sharp objects: knives, scissors, box cutters, tweezers
- Wood items: rulers

- Glass items
- Accessories: backpacks, fanny packs, purses, wallets
- Money or prepaid phone cards
- Electronics: cell phones, pagers, cameras, MP3/CD/DVD players, iPods
- Smoking items: cigarettes, cigars, pipes, vape pens, lighters, matches
- Beverages: alcohol, water, soda
- Snacks: gum, chips, candy
- Controlled substances: unauthorized/illegal drugs
- Hygiene items: mouthwash, toothpaste, toothbrushes
- Weapons: firearms or any objects that can be used as weapons
- Oleoresin Capsicum Spray (O.C. Spray)
