## GLENN E. ROCKEY (1910 - 1955)

### In Remembrance

**HACIENDA FIRE**

On September 2nd in 1955 Captain Glenn Rockey of Engine Company 4 along with five juvenile members of the Los Angeles County Probation Forestry Camp Crew 5-1 were killed in the line of duty while fighting the explosive Hacienda Fire. Rockey was able to rescue seven juveniles of the twelve person crew from a bowl like area before a flashover occurred entrapping Rockey and the remaining five juveniles. In 2012, Captain Glenn Rockey was posthumously awarded the Medal of Valor by Fire Chief Daryl L. Osby.

On September 2, 1955, Los Angeles County Fire Captain Glenn E. Rockey was killed on a La Habra Heights hillside during the "Hacienda Fire", saving seven of the twelve young members of the Los Angeles County Probation Forestry Camp 5-1. Captain Glenn Rockey died trying to save his crew. Camp Rockey is named in his honor.

On January 7th, 2017, the La Habra Heights & Los Angeles County Fire Departments dedicated a monument and plaque to the six firefighters who lost their lives on September 2, 1955, while fighting the "Hacienda Fire" in the area that would become the City of La Habra Heights. 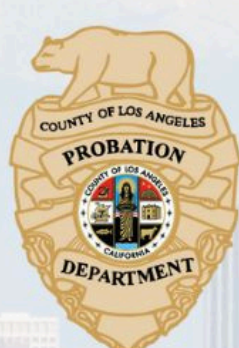




