

### NARRATIVE:

Aguilar has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 21 and includes convictions for hit and run / injury / death, vehicle theft, multiple DUI-alcohol, lewd and lascivious acts with a minor, receiving stolen property and possession of a narcotic controlled substance. Aguilar has served multiple state prison terms, the longest a five (5) year term for hit and run / injury / death. Aguilar was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on July 16, 2012. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in July 2013 after Aguilar absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Aguilar qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for hit and run / injury / death with prior is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His prior criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
