NARRATIVE:

Hayes has an extensive adult criminal history with his first conviction at age 19. His convictions include multiple convictions for battery on spouse, possession of dangerous weapons, prohibited possession of ammunition, multiple convictions for felon in possession of firearm, terrorist threats, larceny, battery of emergency person, trespassing, disobeying court order, possession of controlled substance, false identification to peace officer, obstruction to peace officer, and absconding from supervision. He has served multiple state prison terms the longest a four(4) year term for felon in possession of a firearm. Hayes was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on July 23rd, 2013 Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in March 2014 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Hayes qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for felon in possession of firearm is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code.
