### NARRATIVE:

Hurns, a documented gang member, has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 19. His convictions include assault with a deadly weapon causing great bodily injury, DUI of alcohol and drugs, fighting in public, resisting a public officer, shoplifting, grand theft auto, vehicle theft, failure to appear, evading a peace officer with disregard for safety, possess/manufacture/sales of dangerous weapons, violation of parole, battery on a peace officer, possession of controlled substances, terrorist threats, and disorderly conduct. He has served multiple state prison terms the longest a 3 year 8 month term for possession of controlled substances. Hurns was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on May 29, 2013. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in May 2014 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Hurns qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for the charge of possession of controlled substances is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His prior criminal history, gang member status and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
