NARRATIVE:

Eddie Atkins has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 19. His convictions include terrorist threats, burglary, forgery, domestic violence with injury, grand theft property, attempted grand theft, receiving stolen property, possession of controlled substances for sale, marijuana possession and failing to report. He has served multiple state prison terms the longest being a two year term for terrorist threats. Atkins was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on August 10, 2013. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in January 2015 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Atkins qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for possession of controlled substances for sale is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
