NARRATIVE:

Wilton Miller has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. His convictions include robbery, theft, grand theft auto, vehicle theft, petty theft with prior convictions, possession of narcotic controlled substances, possession of controlled substances and failing to report. He has served multiple incarcerations, the longest being a 3 year term for robbery. Miller was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on November 03, 2013. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in March 2015 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Miller qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for possession of controlled substances is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
