NARRATIVE:

Eric Dawson is a documented gang member and has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. His convictions include multiple cases of felon in possession of a firearm, vehicle theft, grand theft of property, possession of marijuana for sale, vandalism and resisting arrest of an officer. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 16 month term for felon in possession of a firearm. Dawson was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on June 29, 2014. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in May 2015 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Dawson qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for possession of a firearm by a felon is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history, gang member status and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
