### NARRATIVE:

April Flint has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 19. Her convictions include robbery, terrorist threats, vehicle theft, indecent exposure, maintaining a public nuisance, disorderly conduct-solicit lewd acts, prostitution, violation of parole, being under influence of controlled substances, theft of personal property, possession of controlled substances, forgery and false ID to a peace officer. She has served multiple incarcerations, the longest being a 32 month term for possession of controlled substances. Flint was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on December 22, 2011. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. She subsequently failed to report to her probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in December 2014 after she absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Flint qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because her current commitment offense for possession of controlled substances is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. Her criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make her a most wanted. If you know her whereabouts please contact...
