NARRATIVE:

Armando Martinez has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 21. His convictions include murder, multiple cases of battery, multiple domestic violence with injury, assault with a deadly weapon causing great bodily injury, possession of controlled substances, trespassing and driving with a suspended license. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 13 year term for murder. Martinez was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on July 8, 2014. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in September 2015 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Martinez qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for possession of controlled substances is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
