NARRATIVE:

Royelle Outlaw is a gang member with an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. His convictions include multiple cases of a felon in possession of a firearm, firearm access violation, carrying a concealed weapon, assault with a deadly weapon causing great bodily injury, grand theft of person, possession of controlled substances for sale, false identification to a peace officer, fraudulent checks, resisting arrest, driving without a license and minor in possession of alcohol. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 5 year term for grand theft of person. Outlaw was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on November 16, 2014. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in August 2015 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Outlaw qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for a firearm access violation is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history, gang member status and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
