NARRATIVE:

Rodney Quinn has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. His convictions include burglary, resisting a peace officer, assault with great bodily injury, vandalism, kidnapping for ransom, robbery, carjacking, hit and run with property damage, grand theft property, possession of narcotic controlled substances, possession of a firearm by felon, inflicting corporal injury on spouse and contraband in prison. He has served multiple incarcerations, the longest being a 10 year term for kidnapping for ransom. Quinn was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on June 20, 2014. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in October 2015 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Quinn qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offenses for contraband in prison is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
